**Advanced Handbells**—A performance class for the advanced handbell ringer by clinician, Sharon Brant (required attendance 1:00-2:25 daily). Will perform in the closing concert on Friday.

**Children’s Choir Resources-ORFF**—The use of ORFF in children’s ministry. Taught by Stephany Herndon Bryant, a certified ORFF instructor and music therapist.

**Choral Techniques**—An interactive discussion of issues facing choral directors. Taught by clinician, Ken Berg.

**Worship Technology**—Creating worship videos, stewardship of technology, and faithful social networking. A relevant discussion of issues in contemporary worship, the use of social networking, and maintaining boundaries between the personal and the professional. **MTR**

**Intermediate Handbells**—Instructional rather than performance-based approach to helping the average ringer with basic skills, techniques, and musicianship for confident, excellent handbell playing. Taught by Joy Toll-Chandler of Lake Placid.

**Creative Worship**—A showcase of the unexpected in worship, taught by clinician, Sharon Brant. Prerequisite—you must be a handbell choir director, or have playing experience in an intermediate or advanced handbell ensemble.

**Sight Reading for the Choir Member**—Fundamentals of music that will improve sight reading, and controlling vocal production for a more rewarding choral experience.

**Beginning Handbells**—For the true beginner with no handbell experience. Basic ringing skills and techniques.

**Changing the Hymnal’s Harmonies**—For church pianists and organists, taught by Dean McIntyre. Arranging and improvising from the hymnal with chords and progressions. Prerequisite—a basic understanding of Common Practice chord structure, including major, minor, and chords of the seventh. **MTR**

**Time Management for the Church Musician**—Practical suggestions and resources to deal with daily time management issues faced by church musicians. **MTR**

**NOTICE**—The Monday-Tuesday-Thursday Classes above (MTR) will join the *Worship & Song Event* on Wednesday.
